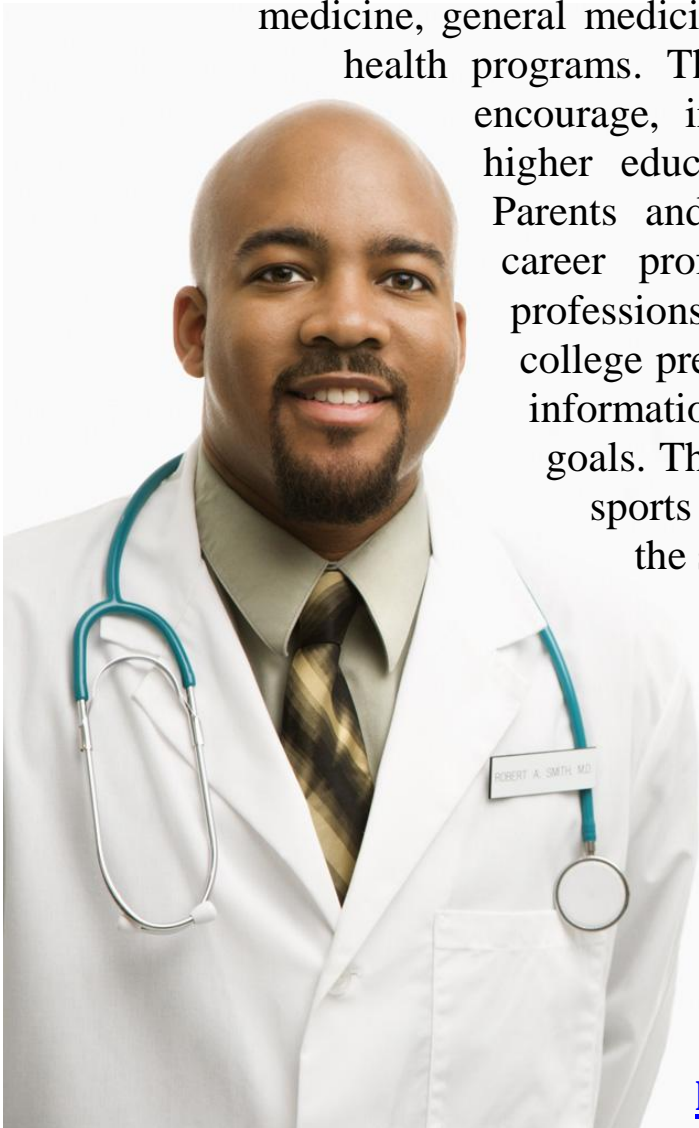

**WHAT:** The Health Sciences Seminar is a two-day fun-filled educational program of presentations and workshops by WVU professionals. Students will be divided into small groups and attend sessions on subjects including: sports medicine, general medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, and allied health programs. The purpose of this program is to encourage, inspire, and motivate students for higher education and health sciences fields. Parents and students are exposed to health career professions, qualifications for these professions, information on high school and college preparatory course work, financial aid information, and advantages to setting career goals.
